Bassinets are one of the most consistently used items on the Alice T. Miner Women and Children's Center, with newborns sleeping in them for the duration of their stay at the hospital. The bassinet is also used for safely transporting the baby to and from the nursery or any other testing area they may need to go.

Bassinets are \$3,500 each and the Center is in need of ten new units for a total cost of \$35,000. Your generosity means our region's tiniest patients will rest easier in their first days of life.

- The Women and Children's Center helps moms deliver nearly 700 babies each year.
- That is an average of nearly 2 births a day.

New bassinets will provide benefits to baby and mother. They are height adjustable and can tilt, making it easier for moms to reach their bundles of joy from their bed, enhancing mother-to-infant closeness. The bassinets also have drawers that open on both sides, eliminating the need to spin the bassinet around to access them when they are against a wall.
