

Student Loan Relief Program



The UVM Health Network-Champlain Valley Physicians Hospital, in partnership with other area hospitals, is proud to announce its Family Medicine Student Loan Relief Program for graduating residents that practice as new Family Medicine physicians to provide better access to primary health care in New York's Adirondack Region.

According to the Association of American Medical Colleges, medical students graduated with an average of \$176,000 in loans in 2014. To help our Family Medicine residents, this progressive Student Loan Relief Program offers up to \$120,000 in incentives.

PARTICIPATING HOSPITALS

The six hospitals in Northern New York participating in this program will provide qualified candidates from our Family Medicine Residency \$20,000 in loan relief per year for three years in return for locating a full-time Family Medicine practice in their community:

- Adirondack Health, Saranac Lake, NY
- Alice Hyde Medical Center, Malone, NY
- Canton-Potsdam Hospital, Potsdam, NY
- Champlain Valley Physicians Hospital, Plattsburgh, NY
- Elizabethtown Community Hospital, Elizabethtown, NY
- Massena Memorial Hospital, Massena, NY

MATCHING DOLLARS

An additional \$20,000 annual match is available to eligible graduates of the CVPH Family Medicine Residency for three years through The University of Vermont Health Network or The UVM Medical Group. The Student Loan Relief Program and matching dollars could total \$120,000 for three years for qualified candidates.
