

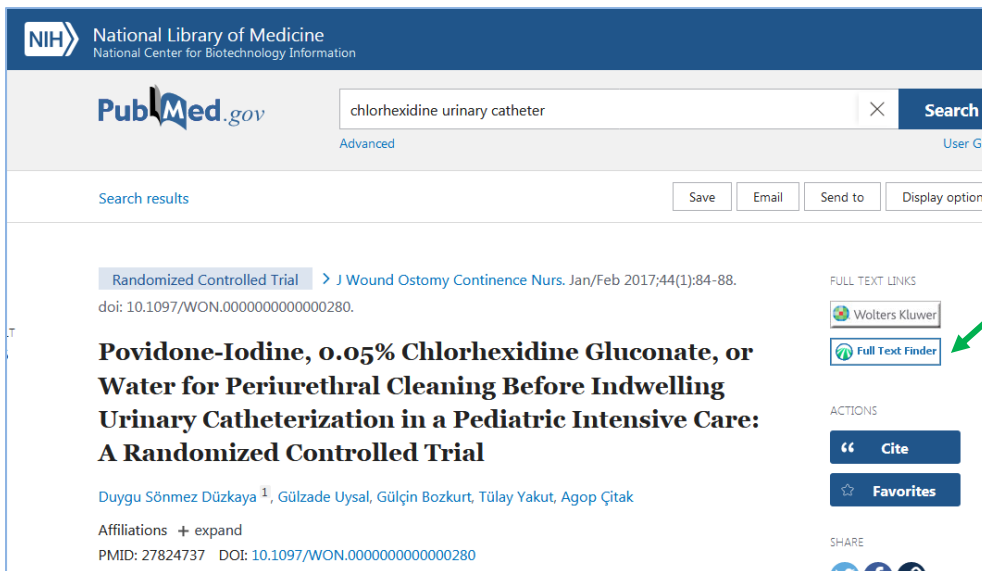
Instructions for Requesting PubMed Articles from Library

Use the CVPH Medical Library's unique link to PubMed on the library home page.

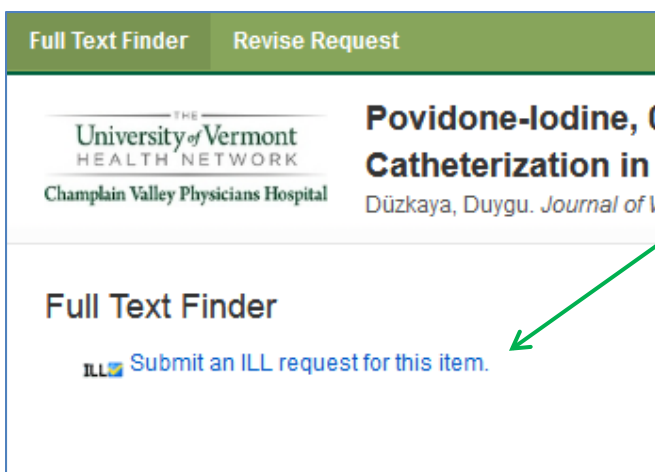
